

Nursing courses from another program are not transferable.

General education credits earned from an accredited institution within ten years of the program start date are considered for transfer. Anatomy and Physiology I and II must have been earned within five years of program start date. To meet the eligibility for transfer, students must provide an official transcript (with course numbers and titles) from the institution where the courses were earned (e.g., #1234567890 #1234567890 accepted).

Course description and syllabi may be required to determine equivalency. Each enrolled student will receive an official transfer letter stating the courses approved for transfer. The transfer of credit will not affect the student's cumulative grade point average.

Once enrolled, students are required to complete courses offered by Pennsylvania Highlands Community College during the scheduled semester following our curriculum plan. If enrolled students
