The individual will be required to submit a written statement from their personal physician describing the disability and outlining the abilities and limitations expected in relation to the performance of radiologic technology tasks and educational requirements. The student will be evaluated by the Conemaugh Occupational Health Department and possibly referred for additional professional evaluation. Information in the type of necessary accommodations could be gathered from the individual, medical experts and educational/vocational experts.

Final determination of the feasibility of the accommodation will be based on safety features and level of undue burden and maintenance of the fundamental nature of the educational services provided by the School.

The following information is in accordance with the American Disabilities Act.
